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Preparation of a Vendor Directory of Commercial Electric Cooking Solution Providers under the Go Electric Campaign

1. Introduction

The Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), functioning under the aegis of the Ministry of Power, Government of India, invites manufacturers, authorised distributors, system integrators, and solution providers of commercial electric cooking equipment to submit their particulars for inclusion in the Go Electric Commercial Electric Cooking Vendor Directory. This Notice sets out the background, purpose, eligibility, and procedure for participation, and includes the registration forms at Annexure I and the Undertaking at Annexure II.

2. About the Bureau of Energy Efficiency

The Government of India established the Bureau of Energy Efficiency on 1st March 2002 under the provisions of the Energy Conservation Act, 2001. The mission of BEE is to develop policies and strategies, with a thrust on self-regulation and market principles, aimed at reducing the energy intensity of the Indian economy. Towards this end, BEE is empowered to notify energy-intensive industries and establishments as designated consumers, prescribe energy consumption norms and standards, mandate energy audits and certified energy managers, prescribe energy conservation building codes, and mandate labelling and energy performance standards for notified equipment and appliances.

3. About the Go Electric Campaign

The Go Electric Campaign is a flagship initiative of BEE under the Ministry of Power, aimed at promoting the adoption of clean, energy-efficient, and electricity-based technologies across sectors. In the context of commercial cooking, the Campaign seeks to accelerate the transition from conventional fuel-based cooking systems to electric cooking technologies — particularly induction-based solutions — across restaurants, hotels, cloud kitchens, industrial canteens, hospitals, hostels, educational institutions, and other commercial and institutional establishments.

Commercial electric cooking technologies offer significant benefits in terms of energy efficiency, energy savings, reduced indoor pollution, improved safety, and greater heat control and automation. Through this Campaign, BEE aims to create awareness among commercial users about these advantages and to support informed decision-making regarding the adoption of electric cooking solutions. As part of this initiative, BEE is also developing guidance and awareness resources to help commercial and institutional users assess their readiness for electric cooking, understand available technology options, and identify equipment suited to their operational requirements.

4. Objective of this Notice

The objective of this Notice is to invite manufacturers, authorised distributors, system integrators, and solution providers of commercial electric cooking equipment for inclusion in the Go Electric Commercial Electric Cooking Vendor Directory. The Vendor Directory will serve as a centralised, publicly accessible platform through which commercial and institutional users — including hotels, restaurants, canteens, hospitals, educational institutions, and community kitchens — can identify and connect with credible providers of electric cooking solutions. It will also give participating manufacturers and solution providers greater visibility for their products and services, while helping consumers access reliable information on available technologies, providers, service networks, and support mechanisms.

5. Scope of Engagement

5.1 Registration

Manufacturers, authorised distributors, system integrators, and solution providers of commercial electric cooking equipment may register for inclusion in the Vendor Directory by furnishing complete and accurate information on their organisation profile, contact details, legal status, business registration, financial capability, product and service portfolio, applicable certifications, technical capabilities, and past experience in the field.

5.2 Product and Information Dissemination

Registered providers shall furnish updated information on their commercial electric cooking equipment, technologies, product specifications, applications, and services for inclusion in the Vendor Directory, supported by relevant technical documentation and certifications, and shall promptly inform BEE of any significant changes to this information.

5.3 Awareness Generation and Consumer Outreach

Registered providers may be given the opportunity to participate in workshops, exhibitions, demonstrations, roadshows, webinars, and other outreach activities organised under the Go Electric Campaign, and may showcase their products and solutions to commercial and institutional users to support informed technology adoption.

5.4 Coordination and Compliance

Registered providers shall nominate a designated representative for coordination with BEE, shall comply with all applicable statutory, regulatory, quality, and safety requirements relevant to their products and services, and shall be subject to verification of submitted details by BEE as required.

6. Who May Apply

- Manufacturers and Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) of commercial electric cooking equipment
- Authorised distributors, dealers, and importers
- EPC / System Integrators and Kitchen Solution Providers

Only commercial electric cooking equipment intended for commercial use will be considered for registration. Eligible product categories include, among others, commercial induction ranges, hobs and wok cookers, electric griddles, grills, deep fryers, tilting pans, steam cookers, combi ovens, conventional electric ovens, commercial microwave ovens, bain maries, and portable equipment such as electric pressure cookers, commercial rice cookers, portable induction hot plates, and electric kettles.

7. Information and Documents to be Submitted

Applicants are required to furnish, among other details, the following, duly signed and stamped on all pages:

- Organisation profile, PAN, GST, CIN/LLPIN, MSME registration (if applicable), and contact details
- Details of products and solutions offered for commercial electric cooking applications, including technical specifications, capacities, and key features
- Relevant certifications, test reports, and applicable quality standards (such as BIS, ISO, UL, or IEC), where available
- Details of manufacturing/assembly facilities, annual production capacity, and country of origin
- Details of installation support, after-sales service, and maintenance infrastructure and manpower
- Case studies, references, or details of major installations completed in the last three to five years
- Details of financing support offered to buyers, if any (such as leasing, EMI, or ESCO-based models)
- Details of training support offered, such as chef, operator, installation, or maintenance training
- A signed declaration confirming the accuracy of the information furnished and compliance with applicable Indian laws

A consolidated product catalogue containing specifications of all listed products, along with supporting certificates and test reports, should also be provided. The complete registration forms are provided at Annexure I, and the Undertaking to be submitted on non-judicial stamp paper is provided at Annexure II.

8. Supporting Documents

Applicants should be prepared to furnish the following supporting documents, where applicable: Certificate of Incorporation; GST Registration; PAN; MSME Certificate; Product Catalogue/Brochure; applicable BIS Certificate(s); Test Reports; ISO Certificates; Dealer/Distributor Authorisation; Company Profile; List of Major Installations; Service Network Details; Sales Volume for the last three years; and certification, if any, under ISO 9000/ISO 14000/ISO 18000 (or equivalent management-system standards).

9. Registration Cycle

Registration for inclusion in the Vendor Directory will be invited on an ongoing basis, four times each year, through the following cycles:

1. January cycle
2. April cycle
3. July cycle
4. October cycle

All supporting documents must be submitted at least one month prior to the commencement of the relevant quarterly cycle. Applications received in each cycle will be evaluated by BEE against the prescribed eligibility criteria and documentation requirements, and successful applicants will be included in the Vendor Directory accordingly.

11. Mode of Submission

Complete applications, along with all supporting documents, should be submitted by email to vikash.jha@beeindia.gov.in; info.ecooking@beeindia.gov.in on or before the last date and time specified above. Incomplete applications, or applications containing inaccurate information, are liable to be rejected.

12. Responsibilities of Registered Providers

- Ensure that all submitted information remains accurate, current, and duly supported by documentation
- Promptly inform BEE of any changes in organisational details, product offerings, or contact information
- Provide factual and verifiable information regarding product performance, specifications, and operational requirements
- Support awareness creation and dissemination of information relating to commercial electric cooking technologies, as and when required

13. General Conditions

- Submission of an application does not guarantee inclusion in the Vendor Directory
- BEE reserves the right to accept or reject any application without assigning any reason
- BEE may seek additional documents or verify the information submitted at any stage
- BEE reserves the right to verify submitted information and to suspend or remove any listing found to be inaccurate, misleading, incomplete, or inconsistent with the objectives of the Go Electric Campaign
- BEE reserves the right to modify, update, amend, or withdraw any part of this Notice, the eligibility requirements, or the registration process at any stage, without assigning any reason

Submission of an application shall be deemed to indicate that the applicant has carefully reviewed and understood the requirements, terms, and conditions set out in this Notice and agrees to abide by them.

14. Use of Information

Information furnished by registered providers may be used by BEE for the preparation of the Vendor Directory, awareness campaigns, digital platforms, and other outreach activities under the Go Electric Campaign, with the objective of assisting commercial and institutional users in making informed purchase decisions based on technology, economic, operational, and safety considerations.
