It has been decided to make following amendments to the aforesaid RfP as tabulated below.

Clauses such as limitation of liability, indemnity, and retention of rights are standard components of the final contract agreement to be signed with the successful bidder. These provisions will be addressed in the contractual agreement, which will be issued after the conclusion of the tender process.
